As OTA looks to the future, it hopes to expand its services to reach out to even more troops, veterans and their families, especially now with their new headquarters.

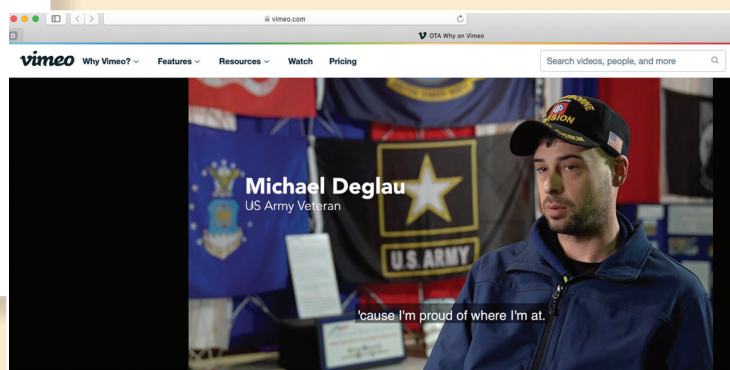
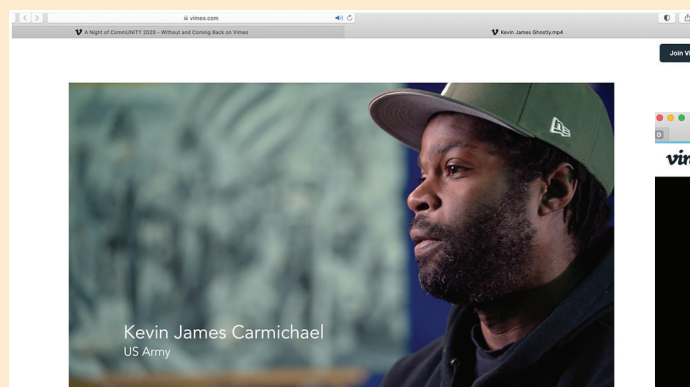
